

Individual Trap Report: Monsignor Paul Dwyer C.H.S. Trap # EQP-CLL-527

Your classroom made an important contribution to the Fall 2013 <u>School Malaise Trap Program</u> and helped to make it a huge success. Your trap collected a total of 546 specimens in week 1 and 530 specimens in week 2. Summed across the two weeks, your sample ranked 15 out of 21 for the total number of specimens collected. Within your sample, there were 137 species, which ranks your sample 15 out of 21 for species diversity. The species you collected came from several different groups (see pie chart below) and included 8 *new* species to our DNA barcode library and 37 species were *only* collected in your trap. Your class should be pleased to have made this contribution to the <u>International Barcode of Life</u> project, the largest endeavour in biodiversity science.
