

Individual Trap Report: Georgetown District High School Trap # EQP-CLL-520

Your classroom made an important contribution to the spring 2014 <u>School Malaise Trap Program</u> and helped to make it a huge success. Your trap collected a total of 46 specimens in week 1 and 157 specimens in week 2. Summed across the two weeks, your sample ranked 44 out of 21 for the total number of specimens collected. Within your sample, there were 60 species, which ranks your sample 16 out of 58 for species diversity. The species you collected came from several different groups (see pie chart below) and included 1 *new* species to our DNA barcode library and 4 species were *only* collected in your trap. Your class should be pleased to have made this contribution to the International Barcode of Life project, the largest endeavour in biodiversity science.
