

Individual Trap Report: Mornington Central School Trap # EQP-CLL-589

Your classroom made an important contribution to the spring 2014 <u>School Malaise Trap Program</u> and helped to make it a huge success. Your trap collected a total of 133 specimens in week 1 and 112 specimens in week 2. Summed across the two weeks, your sample ranked 38 out of 58 for the total number of specimens collected. Within your sample, there were 40 species, which ranks your sample 39 out of 58 for species diversity. The species you collected came from several different groups (see pie chart below) and included 1 *new* species to our DNA barcode library and 2 species were *only* collected in your trap. Your class should be pleased to have made this contribution to the International Barcode of Life project, the largest endeavour in biodiversity science.
