

Individual Trap Report: Pacific School of Innovation and Inquiry Trap # EQP-CLL-544

Your classroom made an important contribution to the Fall 2014 School Malaise Trap Program and helped to make it a huge success. Your trap collected a total of 250 specimens in week 1 and 89 specimens in week 2. Summed across the two weeks, your sample ranked 44 out of 59 for the total number of specimens collected. Within your sample, there were 49 species, which ranks your sample 57 out of 59 for species diversity. The species you collected came from several different groups (see pie chart below) and 18 species were *only* collected in your trap. Your class should be pleased to have made this contribution to the International Barcode of Life project, the largest endeavour in biodiversity science.
