Individual Trap Report: Shoal Lake School Trap # EQP-CLL-498

Your classroom made an important contribution to the Spring 2015 [School Malaise Trap Program](#) and helped to make it a huge success. Your trap collected a total of 460 specimens in week 1 & 2 and 119 specimens in week 3. Summed across the three weeks, your sample ranked 26 out of 68 for the total number of specimens collected. Within your sample, there were 125 species, which ranks your sample 16 out of 68 for species diversity. The species you collected came from several different groups (see pie chart below) and 22 species were *only* collected in your trap. Your class should be pleased to have made this contribution to the [International Barcode of Life](#) project, the largest endeavour in biodiversity science.
