

Individual Trap Report: The York School Trap # EQP-CLL-915

Your classroom made an important contribution to the Fall 2015 <u>School Malaise Trap Program</u> and helped to make it a huge success. Your trap collected a total of 101 specimens in week 1 and 118 specimens in week 2. Summed across the two weeks, your sample ranked 53 out of 64 for the total number of specimens collected. Within your sample, there were 72 species, which ranks your sample 36 out of 64 for species diversity. The species you collected came from several different groups (see pie chart below) and 13 species were *only* collected in your trap. Your class should be pleased to have made this contribution to the <u>International Barcode of Life</u> project, the largest endeavour in biodiversity science.
