

School Individual Trap Keport: School Talaise Timiskaming District Secondary School Trap # EQP-CLL-924

Your classroom made an important contribution to the Fall 2015 School Malaise Trap Program and helped to make it a huge success. Your trap collected a total of 598 specimens in week 1 and 646 specimens in week 2. Summed across the two weeks, your sample ranked 9 out of 64 for the total number of specimens collected. Within your sample, there were 114 species, which ranks your sample 27 out of 64 for species diversity. The species you collected came from several different groups (see pie chart below) and 24 species were only collected in your trap. Your class should be pleased to have made this contribution to the International Barcode of Life project, the largest endeavour in biodiversity science.
