

## Individual Trap Report: John T. Tuck School Trap # EQP-CLL-919

Your classroom made an important contribution to the Fall 2016 School Malaise Trap Program and helped to make it a huge success. Your trap collected a total of 960 specimens in week 1 and 5000 specimens in week 2. Summed across the two weeks, your sample ranked 1 out of 67 for the total number of specimens collected. Within your sample, there were 108 species, which ranks your sample 20 out of 67 for species diversity. The species you collected came from several different groups (see pie chart below) and 26 species were only collected in your trap. Your class should be pleased to have made this contribution to the International Barcode of Life project, the largest endeavour in biodiversity science.
